

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING ARTICLES TO THE
TRINITY JOURNAL OF CHURCH AND THEOLOGY

The following guidelines have been provided to aid writers who intend to submit articles for consideration and publication in the TJCT. Further guidance and direction will be provided if requested.

1. Articles should address theological, religious, social and ecclesial issues that are of relevance to both the academy and the church.
2. An article must be between 5,000 and 8,000 words, and must include an abstract of about 350 words.
3. Citation of sources must employ the Chicago Manual of Style (16th Edition) or Turabian. Use endnotes and provide full bibliographical details of all works cited.
4. Both British and American English spelling and usage are acceptable although writers are required to use this in a consistent manner.
5. If Greek or Hebrew (or other non English) characters are used, they should be embedded to retain them accurately during electronic transmission.
6. Writers must provide the following information about themselves
 - a) Full name and title
 - b) Name of university or institution
 - c) Current position/occupation
 - d) Research interest/area
 - e) A mailing address
 - f) An electronic (e-mail) address
 - g) A mobile telephone number
7. An article must be submitted at least six months before the date of publication, ie,
 - 31st March for the September issue.
 - 30th September for the March issue.
